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For a totally carefree camping holiday, where you can travel light and be inside your tent with the kettle boiling within minutes of arriving on the farm, the campsite has a few canvas bell tents for hire.

These traditional style, sturdy tents are provided pre-erected and fully equipped with all the kit you need for up to 4 people, allowing you to enjoy every last minute of your holiday.

Troytown Campsite is a stunning location, on the waters edge of the remote island of St Agnes, with incredible panoramic views across the Atlantic, the rugged western rocks and the uninhabited island of Annet.



Wake up to the sound of the sea, spend your day relaxing by the clear water and white sands of the campsite's own beach, then after some alfresco dining, watch the sunset from your tent, and count shooting stars in the night sky.

St Agnes is the perfect place to relax and unwind. If you love the outdoors and adventure, this island has a rugged, natural landscape to explore. The clear waters are perfect for snorkelling, kayaking, fishing and swimming, and the beaches have beautiful white sand and are great for rock-pooling or just sitting and watching the ocean.

St Agnes and the adjoining island of Gugh are beautiful and unspoilt, designated as an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The island is only one mile across so the many coves and coves can be explored on foot.

What's Included?

The tents are in a fantastic location on the site with great panoramic views and include:

- Quality, comfortable, pre-inflated airbeds (double and/or singles as required)
- Picnic bench outside your tent
- Comfortable camping chairs
- Lantern and solar powered decorative lighting
- Cooler box with free ice pack service
- Rugs, door mats, dustpan & brush
- Cooking pots, frying pan, kettle & water carrier
- China crockery(6 x plates, bowls, side plates & mugs)
- Proper steel cutlery (6 x knives, forks, spoons, teaspoons)
- Camping stove with two burners and grill. Gas for the cooker is also included.
- Utensils (peeler, masher, corkscrew, sharp knives, chopping board, wooden spoons, spatula, scissors, cheese grater)
- Buckets, spades, & crabbing lines to keep the kids (or young at heart) busy.
- When you arrive on St Agnes, we will meet you at the quay on St Agnes to transport your luggage to the site, and take it down to the boat for you when you leave.



Note : Bedding and towels are not included - please bring sleeping bags and pillows. We also advise that you bring a torch as there is no street lighting on the island.

The above rates are for hire of a pre-erected 4m bell tent, including camping equipment as specified, camping gas for the cooker and return transportation of your luggage across the island for up to 4 people. Rentals are for full weeks - changeover days vary. Dogs are not permitted in our bell tents.		
Short Breaks	Short breaks are available to book outside the school holiday periods. The minimum length of stay is 3 nights.	£50 per night
Extra Person	Subject to availability, an extra person can be accommodated in a separate small tent with mattress we can provide next to your bell tent.	£80 per week

The campsite

The campsite is a made up of a few small fields separated by low granite walls. There are no tall hedges to obscure the great views (or shelter you from bad weather). A granite building on the site houses the facilities, including:

- Toilets, hot showers and hand-basins
- Hair dryers (20p coins), baby changing station
- Washing up area & laundry facilities including a washing machine (3 x £1), tumble dryer (50p coins) and ironing facilities
- Secure lockers with electricity points for charging mobile phones, laptops, mp3s etc..



Campsite facilities

Water on St Agnes comes from underground wells and collected rainwater. The water is treated and regularly tested. Water is precious here and very occasionally we may have to limit it's use at the busiest times during prolonged dry spells. For this reason our showers are operated by tokens (60p) which are purchased from our farm shop.

How to book



Bell Tents are available to rent from April - October. We start taking bookings one year in advance and we advise booking as early as possible for the school summer holiday periods. We require a deposit of 25% at the time of booking. The balance for your holiday is due during your stay.

We also offer campsite pitches if you wish to bring your own equipment and we have three self-catering lets — please ask for details.

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The farm & farm Shop



Troytown is also a working farm, with a small herd of Jersey and Ayrshire dairy cows. There are also calves and pigs which are reared for meat and we grow a small amount of fruit and vegetables. We have a small dairy and farm shop on site which sells:

- Luxury ice-cream made with our own milk and cream. Fresh Troytown milk, yogurt, clotted cream and butter, all produced in our dairy
- A delicious range of Troytown reared beef and pork — steaks, sausages, bacon, burgers, mince and more!
- Vegetables and fruit grown on the farm (seasonal availability)

We also stock a range of camping supplies including charcoal and washing powder. The islands grocery store also operates a service so that you can pre-order a box of groceries to be delivered on the day of your arrival.

Getting to and Around the Islands

You travel to the Isles of Scilly by ship or helicopter from Penzance, or by plane from Lands End, Newquay, Exeter, Bristol or Southampton. These all arrive at the main island of St Mary's, and from there it is just a fifteen-minute boat trip to St Agnes.

The campsite is for tents only; no caravans are allowed in Scilly and cars are left on the mainland (secure parking is available).

Once you arrive on St Agnes at Per Conger quay, it is a 15 minute walk across the island to the site. We will transport your luggage by tractor and trailer from the quay to the site.



Please keep individual bags to a maximum weight of 20kg as they are moved manually.

There are regular boat trips from St Agnes to other islands around Scilly, sightseeing, fishing trips and to see some of the more remote uninhabited islands.

Once here, it is easiest to get around the island on foot, although some roads around the site are rough, so please bear this in mind if you have limited mobility.
