Wake up to the sound of the sea, spend your day relaxing by the clear water and white sands of the campsite's own beach, then after some alfresco dining, watch the sunset from your tent, and count shooting stars in the night sky.

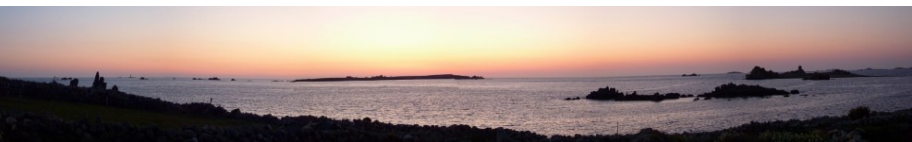
The site is made up of a few small fields with dry stone wall boundaries. We offer traditional camping holidays where campfires are welcome and you won't find electrical hook-ups or caravans here.

St Agnes is the perfect place to relax and unwind. If you love the outdoors and adventure, this island has a rugged, natural landscape to explore. The clear waters are perfect for snorkelling, kayaking, fishing and swimming, and the beaches have beautiful white sand and are great for rock-pooling or just sitting and watching the ocean.

St Agnes and the adjoining island of Gugh are beautiful and unspoilt, designated as an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The island is only one mile across so the many coves and coves can be explored on foot.

The campsite

A granite building on the site houses the facilities, including:

- Toilets, hot showers and hand-basins
- Laundry facilities including a washing machine, tumble dryer and ironing facilities
- Baby Changing station
- Electricity points for charging mobiles / laptops



Campsite facilities

Pitches on the campsite are allocated on arrival. We can cater for any kind of tent, however, at busy times, the smaller your tent, the better your choice of pitches. It is a good idea to opt for a really good quality tent which is the right size for your group rather than a cheaper, larger one - The site will be less crowded and you will stay warm and dry if the weather gets interesting!

We do accept dogs on the site but they must be kept on a lead. At busy times this is strictly limited to one dog per party and we limit the total number of dogs on the site.

Water on St Agnes comes from underground wells and collected rainwater. The water is treated and regularly tested. Water is precious here and very occasionally we may have to limit it's use at the busiest times during prolonged dry spells. For this reason our showers are operated by tokens which are purchased from our farm shop.

Bell-Tent Rental

For a totally carefree camping holiday, where you can travel light, be inside your tent and have the kettle boiling within minutes of arriving on the farm, the campsite has two spacious canvas bell tents for hire on the site. The tents are provided pre-erected and equipped, including:

- One double and two single, high quality, comfortable, pre-inflated airbeds
- Table, chairs, BBQ
- Camping cooker, pots, pans, utensils and table ware
- Gas powered camping fridge
- Camping gas for fridge and cooker included
- Buckets, spades, shrimping net & crabbing lines to keep the kids (or young at heart) busy...



When you arrive on St Agnes, we will meet you at the quay on St Agnes to transport your luggage to the site, and take it down to the boat for you when you leave.

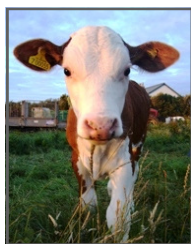
Note : Bedding is not included—please bring sleeping bags and pillows (or similar).

The above rates are for hire of a pre-erected 4m bell tent, including camping equipment as specified, camping gas for the cooker and fridge, and return transportation of your luggage across the island for up to 4 people. Rentals are full weeks with a Saturday changeover. 3 or 4 day stays are sometimes available — see the website for details. Dogs are not permitted.

The farm & farm shop



Troytown is also a working farm, with a small herd of Jersey and Ayrshire dairy cows. There are also calves and pigs which are reared for meat. We have a small dairy and farm shop on site which sells:

- Luxury ice-cream made with our own milk and cream. Fresh Troytown milk, yogurt, clotted cream and butter, all produced in our dairy
- A delicious range of Troytown reared beef and pork — steaks, sausages, bacon, burgers, mince and more!
- St Agnes vegetables and fruit (seasonal availability)

We also stock a range of camping supplies including most types of camping fuel, BBQs, charcoal and washing powder. We also offer a freezer block service.

The islands grocery store also operates a service so that you can pre-order a box of groceries to be delivered on the day of your arrival.



Getting to and Around the Islands

You travel to the Isles of Scilly by ship or helicopter from Penzance, or by plane from Lands End, Newquay, Exeter, Bristol or Southampton. These all arrive at the main island of St Mary's, and from there it is just a fifteen-minute boat trip to St Agnes.

The campsite is for tents only; no caravans are allowed in Scilly and cars are left on the mainland (secure parking is available). You can bring small trailers (up to 3m in length) by arrangement with the ferry company.

Once you arrive on St Agnes at Per Conger quay, it is a 15 minute walk across the island to the site. We can arrange to transport for your luggage by tractor and trailer from the quay to the site. Please keep individual bags to a maximum weight of 20kg.

There are regular boat trips from St Agnes to other islands around Scilly, sightseeing, fishing trips and to see some of the more remote uninhabited islands.

Once here, it is easiest to get around the island on foot, although some roads around the site are rough, so please bear this in mind if you have limited mobility.

How to book



The campsite is open from March-October. During the busiest months of July and August it is essential to book in advance. At other times advance booking of pitches is not essential but advised.

We start taking bookings in October for the following year and we advise booking as early as possible for the school summer holiday period. For pitches, we require a deposit of £2 per person per night at the time of booking. For our inclusive bell-tent holidays, a deposit of 25% is required. The balance for all holidays is due during your stay.
